
2022 Towson Tigers Preview

The 2022 Towson Tigers are led by head coach Jay Ramirez in his third season. He is joined by assistant coach Ashley Sauer and volunteer assistant coach Kristen Presutti Callihan.





The Tigers finished the 2021 season ranked No. 29 with a national qualifying score of 196.006 and a regular season record of 11-13. Their NQS qualified them for regionals for the first time since 2000. Ramirez was named EAGL Coach of the Year and Sauer was named EAGL Assistant Coach of the Year. In addition, Allison Zuhlke was named EAGL Rookie of the Year. Towson had seven placements on the first all-EAGL team and 11 on the second all-EAGL team. There were also 15 gymnasts named to the EAGL all-scholastic team.

The 2022 squad consists of three seniors, five juniors, five sophomores and six freshmen.

The Tigers' top returners are senior Emerson Hurst and juniors Camille Vitoff, Lauren Bolen and Jenna Weitz. Hurst was the 2021 EAGL co-champion on beam and first-team all-EAGL on that event (9.913 NQS) as well as the EAGL Specialist of the

Week for week eight. Vitoff was first-team all-EAGL on vault (9.881 NQS) and second-team on bars (9.844 NQS) and in the all around (38.738 NQS). She was also the EAGL Gymnast of the Week for week five and EAGL Specialist of the Week for week four. Bolen was first-team all-EAGL on vault (9.863 NQS) and in the all around (39.113 NQS) as well as the EAGL Gymnast of the Week for week three. Weitz was first-team all-EAGL on beam (9.856 NQS) and second-team on vault (9.825 NQS) and floor (9.863 NQS) as well as the EAGL Specialist of the Week for weeks five and seven.

Towson brings in six freshmen for the 2022 season: Mia Davis, Clara Hong, Lauren Keener, Steph Macasu, Felicia Poblete and Elise

Tisler. The top freshman contributor is expected to be Hong. She was a level 10 nationals qualifier in 2019 and was the Texas state bars champion that same year as well as the regionals bar champion in 2018.

The Tigers open up the 2022 season on Sunday, Jan 9 at New Hampshire with Southern Connecticut.
