GOTW – Senior Michaela Burton (Downers Grove, Ill.) from Pittsburgh was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on March 3rd. In a meet with West Virginia, Burton came in first place on bars (9.850) and beam (9.900). All six of her scores were 9.850 or higher over the two meets she competed in. Pitt posted their second best score in program history, and highest road score (196.500), after falling to No. 21 Southern Utah on Monday (196.00-197.075).

SOTW – Senior Khazia Hislop (Concord, Mass.) of UNC earned EAGL Specialist of the Week honors on March 3rd. Hislop earned first place in all three events she competed in. Khazia scored a 9.900 on both vault and floor, while posting a 9.8025 on beam. She now is ranked 10th in the nation on vault with an average score of 9.891. This is the seventh Specialist of the Week award for Hislop in eight weeks. The Tar Heels defeated George Washington (196.325-195.500) on Friday.

ROTW – Freshman Ciara Ward (Prince Frederick, Md.) of Pittsburgh was named EAGL Rookie of the Week on March 3rd after recording six scores of 9.775 or higher in the two meets Pittsburgh competed in this week. Wards score of 9.875 on vault (vs. WVU/Rutgers) and 9.825 on bars (vs. Southern Utah) were both career-highs, while posting a score of 9.800 on floor in both meets. Ciara's efforts helped Pittsburgh to a 2-1 weekend with two scores of 196.000 and 196.500.

- The team recorded a 49.000 or higher floor mark for the sixth consecutive meet, posting a 49.075

- Week Eight: GW (11-9, 195.500) @ UNC (7-5, 196.325)
- The Tar Heels earned first place finishes on vault, beam, and tied for first on floor, along with third place finishes on floor and vault, as well
- Posted their second-highest scores of the season as a team on bars (48.850) and beam (49.075)
- They are currently ranked 21st in the nation on vault and 23rd in the nation on floor exercise

- Week Eight: UNH (9-5, 195.050) @ Michigan (12-0, 197.900)
- Alyssa Worthington tied her career high on balance beam with a 9.900 (T-2nd).
- Emma Winer earned the team's best score on floor (9.825) for a seventh straight meet.
- Kylie Gorgenyi recorded the team's best results on vault (9.750) and uneven Bars (9.800, tied with Riley Freehling).

- Week Eight: NC State (12-5, 195.850), Towson (7-8, 193.750) Cornell (5-15, 190.750) @ Penn St. (8-8, 196.575)
- Towson has its second-highest road score of the season (193.750) at a Penn State quad meet.
- The team had its second-highest beam score of the season.
- Kyla Gamble tied her season-high on vault (9.800), while Camille Vitoff and Lauren Bolen set new season-highs of 9.825 and 9.775, respectively.
- Ally Wesoly and Jenna Weitz tied season-highs of 9.800 and 9.750, respectively, on beam, while Emerson Hurst led the way with a 9.850

- The George Washington gymnastics team put together a solid team performance on Friday evening at North Carolina, finishing just behind the host Tarheels 196.325-195.550 under the bright lights of Carmichael Arena.
- The Colonials earned their 195.550 behind team scores of 48.625 on vault, 48.950 on bars, 48.900 on beam, and 49.025 on floor.
- The 195.500 marked the team's third score above the 195.000 threshold this season.
