EAGL 2026 Honors



Co-Gymnasts of the Week - Senior Deana Sheremeta (Circleville, N.Y.) from George Washington and Senior Isabella Minervini (Fleming Island, Fla.) from Towson were voted EAGL Co-Gymnasts of the Week on Feb 25. Sheremeta won floor and the all around, the latter marking a new career high with a 39.225. Her 9.850 on bars was also a personal best. The senior currently leads the EAGL on floor. Minervini tied her season high on bars, which ties for the third highest bars score in Towson history and marked her fifth bars win of the season. The senior also tied a career-high on floor, her third time achieving a 9.900 on floor in her career.

Specialist of the Week - Graduate Student Isabella DeCroo (Warrenton, Va.) from Towson was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Feb 25. DeCroo earned a new career high on the floor, surpassing her former mark that she received at Illinois State in 2022. This was her sixth time in seven meets earning at least a 9.8 on floor and her second podium finish on the event this season.

Rookie of the Week - Freshman Aspen Tucker (Suwanee, Ga.) from George Washington was voted Rookie of the Week on Feb 25. Tucker competed in the all around in and earned a new personal best 38.750. The freshman recorded new personal bests on both beam and floor, with a 9.750 and 9.825 respectively.

Rookie Specialist of the Week - Freshman Jocelyn Lannon (Sutton, Mass.) from Towson was voted EAGL Rookie Specialist of the Week on Feb 25. Lannon earned a career high 9.875 on vault and competed on floor for the first time for a 9.775. This was the freshman's second time in three meets winning vault and her third consecutive meet earning at least a 9.825 on the event.

Weekly Highlights

George Washington

- Current record: 8-10 (0-2 EAGL)
- Week Eight outcome: Third place (194.825) at home against Towson (195.900), Eastern Michigan (195.225), and Fisk (189.800)
- George Washington came in third at home with a 194.850, a new season-high for the team.
- The floor team earned its second highest mark of the season with a 49.125.
- The Revolutionaries had individual winners on both floor and in the all around.

LIU

- Current record: 10-7 (1-3 EAGL)
- Week Eight outcome: Second place (194.525) at home against New Hampshire (194.650), Bridgeport (193.525), and RIC (188.950)
- LIU started the meet with a season high 48.775 on vault.
- The Sharks reached their second highest team score of the season with 194.525.
- The team ended with a strong 48.825 on floor to finish second in the quad.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 13-2 (4-0 EAGL)
- Week Eight outcome: First place (194.650) at LIU (194.525) with Bridgeport (193.525), and RIC (188.950)
- New Hampshire won its first outright EAGL regular-season championship by going 4-0 in league competition.
- The Wildcats registered their highest vault score of the season with a 49.150. Sophomore Mady Harvey and freshman Amelia Lannon each set a personal best with a 9.850 to share first place. Junior captain McCall McMullen equaled her PB with a 9.825 that shared third place with senior Serena Mullin.
- The Wildcats' floor lineup proved outstanding with all five scoring gymnasts achieving a 9.800 or higher en

route to a 49.175. McMullen led the way with a podium-topping 9.875, followed by Gwen Ockerbloom, who tied a season high with a 9.850 to finish second. Junior Poulina Minaev and Mullin each notched a 9.825 for a share of third.

Temple

- Current record: 7-10 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Eight outcome: Win (194.575) at home against Eastern Michigan (193.000)
- Temple junior Amelia Budd shined for the home squad in the meet on Friday. She competed on vault and floor posting a 9.750 and a 9.800 respectively. This marks her third week in a row of scoring a 9.800 or higher on floor.
- Nikki Rengifo remains a consistent force for the Owls on the three events she competes. She notched a 9.775 on vault, a 9.725 on beam, and a 9.775 on floor.
- Sophomore Robyn Dunne bounced back from last week to lead Temple on bars, while also taking first place in the meet overall on that event. Her 9.850 marked a new career high on bars.
- Freshman Jade Harden had perhaps her best night as an Owl on Friday. She marked a 9.800 on vault and then scored a 9.750 on floor, her first time competing on the apparatus in her collegiate career.

Towson

- Current record: 8-5 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Eight outcome: First place (195.900) at George Washington (194.825) with Eastern Michigan (195.225) and Fisk (189.800)
- Towson won the quad-meet at EAGL foe George Washington with its top team score (195.900) of the season.
- The Tigers tied a season-best 49.225 on floor, which was their sixth meet with at least a 49 on floor.
- The team also earned a season-best 49.125 on vault, tied for ninth-best in Towson history.
