EAGL 2024 Honors

Gymnast of the Week: Sophomore Syd Morris (Landenburg, Pa.) of LIU was named EAGL Gymnast of the Week for the second time this season on February 28. Morris won the all-around at two of the three meets the Sharks competed in during the past week, highlighted by a season high 39.400 at the dual meet with Bowling Green where Morris was the runner-up. At the same meet, Morris posted a career high 9.925 on floor to tie LIU's program record on the event. On beam the sophomore currently ranks first in EAGL and ninth in the NCAA.

Specialist of the Week: Sophomore Isabella Minervini (Fleming Island, Fla.) of Towson picked up her second consecutive EAGL Specialist of the Week on February 28. At Towson's tri meet with LIU and Temple, Minervini posted her second consecutive 9.975 of the season on bars to place first overall. She received a perfect 10.0 from one judge for the second time in her collegiate career. The sophomore's performance contributed towards Towson posting a program record 49.450 on the event. On floor, she matched her career high 9.900 to help the team log a program high 49.650. Currently Minervini Ranks seventh in the NCAA on bars and first in EAGL.

Rookie of the Week: Freshman Retoshia Halsell (Louisville, Ky.) earned her third consecutive EAGL Rookie of the Week on February 28. At Towson's tri meet Halsell logged her fourth 9.850 of the season on fourth, which matches her collegiate career high to place fourth overall. She followed up by earning a career high 9.975 on floor, which was a .100 increase from her score at the last meet, to tie for first overall. Her score ranks second in Towson program history. Halsell also contributed to the Tigers program high floor score of 49.650.

Weekly Highlights

George Washington

- Current record: 12-8 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Seven Outcome: Fell to Ball State in a dual meet on Feb. 23 with a score of 196.250.
- Posted 49s on vault (49.150), beam (49.275) and floor (49.375).
- Brooke Izzo placed first overall on beam with a 9.900.
- Anneliese Silverman (39.325) and Kendall Whitman (39.300) set new career bests on all-around.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 15-7 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Seven Outcome: Placed second at All-American Challenge with a 193.325 on Feb. 19 before winning senior day quad meet with a 195.200 on Feb. 25.
- Kylie Gorgenyi set UNH's all-time high score on bars (9.975) and matched the highest all-around score in program history of 39.475, a 20 year-old mark.
- Wildcats scored a season-high 49.275 on bars supported by Gorgenyi's 9.975 as well as a 9.925 from Jenna DeVincenzo, 9.850 from Kenadi Brown and 9.775 from Gianna Graver.
- Gorgenyi secured four first-place finishes including her sixth all-around gold. Freshman Gwen Ockerbloom won beam with a career high 9.850.

LIU

- Current record: 10-7 (0-3 EAGL)
- Week Seven Outcome: Competed in three competitions within a week and had better scores with each outing: All-American Challenge - 192.025, Towson/Temple Tri - 193.425, Bowling Green dual - 195.875.
- Posted a season high team score at the Bowling Green dual as well as season high bars (49.1) and floor (49.225).
- Cael Bixler posted career high 9.975 on beam, Syd Morris scored season high 39.4 on AA and on floor of 9.925, Brisa Carraro had career high 9.95 on beam which ties for second best score in LIU program history, Alana Ricketts scored 9.875 on vault to tie the school record.
- Overall the Sharks tied three school records and posted third highest team score in program history.

Temple

- Current record: 9-9 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Seven Outcome: Earned 49's on vault and floor at Towson's tri meet, finishing second with the second highest score of the season - 195.525.
- The Owls had 13 routines score 9.8 or better throughout all four events.
- The second time this season the team scored 49's in two events in one meet.
- Seven gymnasts earned top five scores.

Weekly Highlights

- Current record: 12-7 (4-0 EAGL)
- Week Seven Outcome: Won a tri meet against Temple and LIU with a 197.425 to clinch EAGL Regular Season Champion title.
- Broke 197 for the first time in history, posting a program best 197.425 supported by 49's on all four events.
- Posted program records on bars (49.450) and floor (49.650).
- Four gymnasts received a perfect 10.0 from one judge on their respective events (Grace Vaillancourt - bars, Isabella Minervini - bars, Elise Tisler - floor, Retoshia Halsell - floor).
