

George Washington's Anna Warhol Named EAGL Scholar-Athlete of the Year

Warhol achieved a 4.0 GPA for the calendar year to earn first EAGL annual award

DURHAM, N.H. (March 31, 2020) – The East Atlantic Gymnastics League announced junior Anna Warhol (Poland, Ohio) of George Washington as the 2020 Scholar-Athlete of the Year on Tuesday, March 31. Warhol achieved a 4.0 GPA for the calendar year as well as a 3.86 cumulative GPA. Anna excelled in the classroom as a Biomedical Engineering major.

Warhol also contributed to the Colonials success in competitions this season, earning All-EAGL second team honors on bars and floor. This was her first collegiate season competing in floor, scoring above a 9.725 in all nine meets in which she was in the floor lineup. Warhol also posted an NQS of 9.795 of bars and 9.720 on vault.

Outside of the classroom and gymnasium, Warhol held a coveted research position at the Cleveland Clinic this past summer with the Cardiovascular and Metabolic Sciences department, ranked the first of its kind in the nation.
