Emily Shepard, Chloe Negrete and Kasey Nelson qualified for Second Team All-EAGL in the event. The Wolfpack finished the season at the top of the EAGL standings on floor in NQS, average and high. NC State tied the sixth-highest floor score in program history with a 49.400 on Feb. 15.

Bob Starkell

Starkell helped five members of the Wolfpack qualify for First Team All-EAGL on bars: Lauren Kent, Meredith Robinson, Emily Shepard, Katie Cox and Drew Grantham. The Wolfpack finished the season at the top of the EAGL standings on bars in NQS, average and high. The Wolfpack are the only team in the EAGL with an NQS above 49.000 on bars. The Wolfpack's two all-arounders, Lauren Kent and Drew Grantham, both qualified for All-EAGL First Team in all-around. Nationally, NC State sits at No. 23 with an NQS of 196.130. The Wolfpack additionally is in the top 25 on bars (No. 25), and floor (No. 23).
