GYMNAST OF THE WEEK:

For the second-straight week and third time this season, Senior Jillian Winstanley (Arlington, Mass.) of George Washington earned the EAGL Gymnast of the Week honor after posting the highest all-around in EAGL this season (39.525) en route to her team tallying the top total in EAGL so far in 2018 (196.525). In GW's Pink meet where the Colonials went 3-0 against Kent State, William & Mary and UW-Oshkosh, Winstanley placed first in the all-around while tying for first on vault (9.900). Additionally she collected two more second-place finishes (9.875 bars and 9.875 beam) and tied for third on floor (9.875). Winstanley earned her third all-around title of the 2018 season and her 39.525 puts her in sole possession of fourth place on GW's all-time all-around score list (her career-high is a 39.550). Winstanley finished on the all-around podium for the fifth-straight week. She has scored above a 39.000 in the last four meets and has broke the 39.000 threshold 11 times since the start of the 2017 season.

SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK:

For the second time this season, senior Casey Lauter (Northport, New York) from the University of New Hampshire, was recognized as EAGL Specialist of the Week for her spectacular beam performance. In an EAGL dual where UNH posted a season-high 196.125 to defeat North Carolina, Lauter matched her career-high (9.950) and recorded the highest score on beam out of any EAGL gymnast this season. She now holds highest beam average in EAGL and the seventh highest average beam score in the nation (9.900). Only eight gymnasts in the country have recorded a higher score this season on beam.

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Freshman Haley Brechwald (Springfield, Va.) collected her third EAGL Rookie of the Week award after claiming the all-around title in a home quad meet against Temple, Towson and NC State. She beat out six other all-around gymnasts with a 39.025, while also tying for first on vault (9.825) and floor (9.875). She added a tied-for-third finish on vault (9.700) and tied-for-ninth finish on beam (9.675). The newcomer has now won the all-around for the third time this season and has collected nine total titles.

WEEK FIVE RECAP:

George Washington (10-2/2-0)

3-0 against Kent State, William & Mary, UW-Oshkosh (1. GW 196.525, 2. Kent State 195.325, 3. William & Mary 193.225, 4. UW-Oshkosh 190.925)

- •GW clinched its fourth straight victory with a season-high score of 196.525
- •The Colonials finished the day with season-high performances on vault (49.225), bars (49.075), and floor (49.325).
- Jillian Winstanley completed the day with a second-place finish on allaround podium, scoring a season-high 39.525, a mark that ranks first in the East Atlantic Gymnastics League (EAGL). Fellow senior co-captain Cami Drouin-Allaire joined Winstanley on the podium in third-place with a 39.325, while Alex Zois finished fourth with a career-high 39.200.

North Carolina State (8-3/3-0)

3-0 at Pittsburgh (1. NC State 194.600, 2. Temple 193.875, 3. Pitt 193.125, 4. Towson 192.050)

- •The wins saw NC State move to 8-3 on the season overall and a perfect 3-0 against EAGL competition
- •The Wolfpack earned 11 top-five finishes and tied four individual career-highs and two individual season-highs
- •NC State gymnasts won both vault (Mackenzie) and beam (Chelsea Knight) while the Pack achieved its second-highest floor score and its highest floor score away from home this season (49.150)

North Carolina (4-2/1-2)

- •0-1 at New Hampshire (1. New Hampshire 196.125, 2. North Carolina 195.075)
- •Carolina competed in its first duel match on the road, its second consecutive week of travel.
- •The Tar Heels set ten new season-high scores and three new careerbests. They also collectively tied one season-best score and four personal records over all four rotations.
- •The team set a new season-best rotation score of 49.100 on bars and tied season-highs on vault (49.000) and floor exercise (49.250). This is the first time since 2009 that Carolina has earned three rotation scores of at least 49.000 in the same meet.

- The Wildcats recorded their highest score of the season (196.125).
- UNH recorded season-highs on bars (49.125) and beam (49.125).
- Casey Lauter won beam (9.950), Danielle Mulligan won bars (9.925), and Nicole O'Leary won vault (9.875).

Pittsburgh (2-6/2-1)

1-2 against NC State, Temple, Towson (1. NC State 194.600, 2. Temple 193.875, 3. Pitt 193.125, 4. Towson 192.050)

- \bullet The Panthers finished third in a quad meet, defeating EAGL opponent Towson, while falling to Temple and NC State.
- Pitt saw two individuals take home event titles in freshman Haley Brechwald and sophomore Megan Tripp. Brechwald won the all-around title after tying for first on bars with Tripp and also tying for first on floor.
- The Panthers tallied its highest event mark of the night during its final rotation, scoring a 48.825 on floor.

Towson (4-9/0-5)

0-3 at Pittsburgh (1. NC State 194.600, 2. Temple 193.875, 3. Pitt 193.125, 4. Towson 192.050)

- •Sophomore Melissa Temkov posted career highs on bars and in the allaround as the Tigers finished fourth in a quad meet at Pittsburgh with N.C. State and Temple Saturday at Fitzgerald Field House. No. 25 N.C. State finished first with 194.600 points, followed by Temple (193.875), Pittsburgh (193.125) and Towson (192.050).
- •Temkov was one of three Tigers to post career highs on bars as Towson posted a season high score of 48.850 to finish first among all four teams. Senior Katie McGrady led the way as she finished in a tie for first with a career-high 9.825. Freshman Tess Zientek was fourth with a career-high 9.800 while Temkov and Baker each finished seventh with a 9.775, a new career best for Temkov and just short for Baker.
- •Temkov also posted a career-high in the all-around with a 38.475 to finish sixth while Baker, competing in the first all-around of her career, finished seventh with a 37.950.
- •Senior Tyra McKellar finished second on beam with a season-high 9.750 and fifth on floor with a season-high 9.825.
