Gymnasts of the Week: Junior Sarah Zois (Crofton, Md.) from George Washington and sophomore Syd Morris (Landenburg, Pa.) were named EAGL Co-Gymnasts of the Week on January 17. Zois placed first on vault at the Lindsey Ferris Invitational with a score of 9.850. The Maryland native also set career highs on beam (9.9) and floor (9.875), beating her previous career high on floor by 1.2 points. Syd Morris posted a 9.975 on beam at LIU's first meet to win the event, tying the school record and receiving a perfect score from one judge. With that score, they are currently tied for first in the NCAA rankings on beam. Morris received their second first place finish on all-around, posting the second highest score in LIU program history of 39.375.

Specialist of the Week: Sophomore Serena Mullin (Hamden, Conn.) of New Hampshire and junior Elise Tisler (Fairfax Station, Va.) of Towson were voted EAGL Co-Specialists of the Week on January 17. Mullin tied her career high of 9.8 on vault, previously accomplished in her collegiate debut on Jan. 9 2023. She went on to post a 9.825 on beam, the highest score for New Hampshire, placing second overall. Mullin concluded the meet competing in the floor lineup for her first time, logging a 9.750 which was the third best mark for the Wildcats. Elise Tisler set a new career high of 9.850 on vault, placing fifth overall. She logged a 9.800 on floor which is only .05 off of her career best.

Rookie of the Week: Freshman Kate Parks (Lebanon, Ohio) from LIU was voted EAGL Rookie of the Week on January 17. In her first collegiate meet Parks tied for third overall on bars with a 9.775. The Ohio native anchored for the Sharks on vault, posting a 9.75 to tie for ninth.

- Week One outcome: placed second at a quad meet with Florida (197.100), Fisk(189.950) and Talladega (187.750) with a score of 194.550 | Placed second at Lindsey Ferris Invitational against Penn (195.375), Temple (194.100), Yale (193.325) and Cornell (192.850) with a score of 195.025.
- Three career highs earned at the home opener.
- First-year Delaney Dehaan posted top bar score for GW at UF in her collegiate debut, receiving a 9.775
- Sophia Tyeryar sets career high at second collegiate meet on bars, posting 9.725

LIU

- Current record: 2-0 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week One outcome: Won first meet of the season with a score of 195.225 over New Hampshire (194.800) and Bridgeport (192.800).
- Earned highest opening score in program history (195.225).
- First win in school history over EAGL opponent UNH.
- Syd Morris is ranked first (tied) in the NCAA on beam with a 9.975.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 1-1 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week One outcome: Placed second overall at tri meet with a score of 194.800 against LIU (195.225) and Bridgeport (192.800).
- Scored 49.050 on vault after four Wildcats placed 1-3. All four also earned career highs
- Freshman Anne Challman made her collegiate debut with two second place finishes on vault (9.825) and floor (9.875).
- Graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi picked up four first place finishes on vault (9.875), bars (9.850), floor (9.875) and AA (39.375 career high).

Temple

- Current record: 2-6 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week One outcome: scored a season high 194.100 at the Lindsey Ferris Invitational to place third out of five teams.
- Scored 13 9.7s or better, including all six gymnasts on floor exercise.
- Floor squad received first 49+ score of the season.
- Temple was leading throughout three rotations, but after a bye in rotation four the Owls fell to the Quakers and George Washington.

Weekly Highlights

Towson

- Current record: 0-2 (0-0 EAGL)
- \bullet Week One outcome: placed third at a tri meet with #9 Ohio State (197.100) and Ball

State (195.650) after posting 195.225. Was in the lead throughout two rotations.

• Posted the highest vault score of the meet, 49.250, which is the third highest in program history as well as the highest opening score for Towson. Currently ranked 9th in the nation on vault.

- Posted a 49.275 on floor which ranks 20th in the nation.
- Four Tigers earned career bests, and two placed in the top 3 individually.
- Camille Vitoff received a perfect 9.95 from one judge on vault, scoring a 9.9 and placing second overall.
