

# EAGL 2022 Honors



**Gymnast of the Week** - Graduate Student Deja Chambliss (Chesterfield, Va.) from George Washington was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on Feb 23. Chambliss earned a new career high in the all around, posting the second-highest score in program history. She also tied her career high on bars and set a new career high on beam. The graduate student earned her fourth all around title of the season, placed first on vault, and tied for first on beam and floor.

**Co-Specialists of the Week** - Sophomore Mara Titarsolej (Zutphen, Netherlands) from LIU and Junior Emily Shepard (Olathe, Kan.) from NC State were voted EAGL Co-Specialists of the Week on Feb 23. Titarsolej won the bars title for the fifth time this season. In the first week of calculating rankings with NQS, she is ranked No. 1 in the EAGL and No. 7 nationally with a 9.900 NQS. Shepard tied for second place on all three events she competed. The junior also tied as the highest scorer for NC State on beam and floor and was the second-highest scorer for the team on bars. The meet marks the third competition in a row in which she has posted a 9.825 or higher on each event she competed.

**Rookie of the Week** - Freshman Lali Dekanoidze (Matthews, N.C.) from North Carolina was voted EAGL Rookie of the Week on Feb 23. Dekanoidze earned her fourth all around title of the season, while also taking home the vault, beam and floor titles. She set a new career-best on floor with a 9.900. The freshman currently ranks No. 1 in the all around in the EAGL and is No. 2 on bars and vault. She is also No. 10 nationally in the all around.

# Weekly Highlights

### George Washington

- Current record: 9-8 (2-3 EAGL), 195.040 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Second place (196.375) at Pitt (196.675) with New Hampshire (195.125)
- George Washington scored a season high 196.375—its second 196.000+ of the season.
- The team had season-high scores on bars and beam.
- There were four event scores above the 49.000 mark.

#### LIU

- Current record: 6-11 (0-5 EAGL), 193.795 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: First place (194.000) at Brown (193.225) with Southern Connecticut (189.300) and RIC (183.850)
- LIU had the highest Away Team score in the history of the program—194.000.
- The Sharks broke the school record on VT (48.875).
- There were two individual school records: beam—Ilka Juk (9.925) and vault —Jah'Liyah Bedminster (9.85).
- LIU won every individual event for the first time in school history (vault & floor—Bedminster, bars—Titarsolej, beam—Juk).

#### NC State

- Current record: 8-4 (2-3 EAGL), 195.375 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Loss (196.350) at home against North Carolina (196.625)
- NC State earned its second-highest team score of the season, crossing the 196.000 mark for the second time in 2022.
- The Wolfpack posted its highest vault mark of the year with a 49.050.
- The Pack crossed the 49.000 threshold on three events for the second-straight meet (vault, beam, and floor).

### New Hampshire

- Current record: 6-7 (2-4 EAGL), 194.730 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Third place (195.125) at Pitt (196.675) with George Washington (196.375)
- Hailey Lui shared first place on balance beam with a 9.925.
- The Wildcats' top event was uneven bars (49.050); Kylie Gorgenyi led the way with a 9.875 (T-3rd).
- Jenna DeVincenzo set a career high on bars (9.850) and tied a personal best on balance beam (9.825).

### North Carolina

- Current record: 9-5 (6-0 EAGL), 195.545 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Win (196.625) at NC State (196.350)
- The Tar Heels posted the program's highest team score since Feb. 27, 2004.
- The team clinched the EAGL regular season title—improving to 6-0 in conference meets.

 North Carolina posted a season-best 49.225 on vault and scored a 49.000 or better in all four events for the first time this season.

### Pittsburgh

- Current record: 8-6 (4-1 EAGL), 195.340 NQS
- Week Seven outcome:
  - Meet 1: Second place (196.450) at Maryland (196.700) with Minnesota (196.225)
  - Meet 1: First place (196.675) at home against George Washington (196.375) and New Hampshire (195.125)
- The Panthers posted the highest overall score in program history on Sunday vs. GW and UNH—196.775.
- Throughout the week, the team broke the program bar record on Monday vs. Maryland and Minnesota (49.400) and the beam record on Sunday for the second time this season (49.325).
- Katie Chamberlain tied the Panthers' individual program record on bars with a career-best 9.950 on Monday vs. the Terrapins and the Gophers. She went on to earn two scores over the 9.900 threshold on Sunday – beam (9.925 – career-high) and bars (9.900).

## Temple

- Current record: 7-4 (1-3 EAGL), 194.845 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Win (193.825) at home against Yale (193.075)
- Temple trailed 96.525-95.875 after three rotations on vault, bars, and beam. With the Owls on floor, the Bulldogs were left with beam in the fourth rotation. In the last rotation, the Cherry and White outscored their former ECAC rival 49.100 to 48.125.
- Three of the six Owls scored a 9.800 or better on floor during the final rotation.
- Sophomore Brooke Donabedian scored a 9.900 on floor for the Owls, becoming the eighth gymnast in school history to achieve that mark.

### Towson

- Current record: 12-3 (4-2 EAGL), 195.540 NQS
- Week Seven outcome: Second place (195.525) at home against WVU (196.575) and Ursinus (185.175)
- The Tigers registered another score of 196.000+ for the third time this season, turning in the fourth-best score in program history. Towson scored four 49.000s for the second time this season.
- The Tigers collected seven podium finishes, including four first-place finishes.
- Towson moved to 23rd in this week's Road to Nationals NQS standings, ranking third in the region and second in the EAGL.
