

Gymnast of the Week: Graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi (North Reading, Mass.) of New Hampshire picked up her second consecutive EAGL Gymnast of the Week on February 14. Gorgenyi set a career high of 9.925 on floor to tie for first place overall at the New Hampshire quad meet with Towson, Brown and Rutgers on February 11. Currently the graduate student ranks third in EAGL on floor with a 9.855 average. At the quad meet she earned three other podium finishes including her fourth all-around victory of the season with a score of 39.275. Gorgenyi ranks first in EAGL on all-around.

Specialist of the Week: Junior Elise Tisler (Fairfax Station, Va.) of Towson earned her second EAGL Specialist of the Week this season on February 14. At the New Hampshire quad meet on February 11 she picked up her second individual win of the season on vault after posting a career high 9.925 which ties Towson's top score on the event this season. The junior now ranks second in EAGL on vault with a 9.838 average. On floor she logged her second highest score of the season, receiving a 9.875.

Rookies of the Week: Freshmen Alina Danilchenko (Orlando, Fla.) of LIU and Retoshia Halsell (Louisville, Ky.) were named EAGL Co-Rookies of the Week on February 14. Danilchenko scored two career highs on beam (9.8) and floor (9.875) at the Empire State Collegiate Championship on February 11. She led off for the team on floor, placing second overall which marked her first top three finish as a Shark. Halsell logged a 9.825 on vault for fifth place at the New Hampshire quad meet on February 11 which marked her third score above 9.8 on the event this season. The freshman was also the anchor on floor for the Tigers where she posted a collegiate career high 9.800.

Weekly Highlights

New Hampshire

- Current record: 8-4 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Five Outcome: Posted a season-high 195.875 for third place at a quad meet with Towson (196.300), Rutgers (196.200) and Brown (194.700).
- Graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi posted a personal-best 9.925 on floor and won the all-around for the fourth time to help UNH post a season high. She earned podium finishes on vault (9.850 T3), bars (9.850 T3), floor (9.925 T1) and AA (39.275 1st).
- Senior Jenna DeVincenzo received the team's Katie Baldwin Expression Award after matching her personal best on vault (9.800) and setting a career high on beam (9.850).

Towson

- Current record: 7-6 (2-0 EAGL)
- Week Five Outcome: Placed first with a season high 196.300 at quad meet with Rutgers (196.200), UNH (195.875) and Brown (194.700).
- Earned a season high 49.325 on floor which ties the fifth best score on the event in program history.
- Picked up six podium finishes, two of which were first place victories from Elise Tisler (VT 9.925) and Grace Vaillancourt (BB 9.875).
- Posted 49.225 on vault which is the fourth highest score in program history.

- Current record: 8-3 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Five Outcome: Finished second at the inagural Empire Collegiate Challenge with a 192.5.
- Posted a team score of 49.200 on beam which ties the second highest beam score in school history.
- The Sharks posted 12 season highs out of 24 routines.

Temple

- Current record: 5-8 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Five Outcome: Fell to University of Pennsylvania in a dual meet 194.075 - 195.075.
- The Owls totaled eight scores of 9.8 or better.
- Picked up three indvidual first place finishes on bars beam and floor.
- Brooke Donabedian won floor (9.900) and beam (9.825).
