GOTW – Senior Drew Grantham (Durham, N.C.) from NC State was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on February 25th. In two meets this past week, Grantham scored a 9.925 on floor, coming in first place and tying her career-high in the event both times. Drew also took first place on beam (9.850) and all-around (39.450), and tied for second place on vault (9.825) on Feb. 21. NC State went undefeated in both meets they competed in to improve to 10-4 on the season.

SOTW – Senior Khazia Hislop (Concord, Mass.) of UNC earned EAGL Specialist of the Week honors on February 25th. Hislop earned first place on vault and floor in both of the meets she competed in this week, scoring a 9.900 in both events. This is the sixth Specialist of the Week award for Hislop in seven weeks. Khazia helped the Tar Heels defeat UNH in the two meets they competed in this week.

ROTW - Freshman Emily Shepard (Olathe, Kan.) of NC State was named EAGL Rookie of the Week on February 25th after finishing in first place on vault and bars in both meets she competed in this week. Shepard's scores of 9.850 on vault and 9.875 on bars were both career-highs set on Feb. 21, then tying both on Feb. 23. Shepard contributed to NC State's highest score of the season (196.500) on Feb. 21 and another win on Feb. 23.

 - Senior Michaela Burton earned wins on uneven bars (9.900) and balance beam (9.850)
 - Burton's 9.900 on bars is team-best score on the event this season
 - For the second consecutive meet, senior Alecia Petrikis won floor exercise (9.850)
- UNC** Current Record: 6-5, 2-2 EAGL
- Week Seven: UNH (9-3, 195.650) @ UNC (5-5, 196.050)
UNC (6-5, 196.100) @ UNH (9-4, 195.300)
 - The Tar Heels earned first place finishes on vault, bars, beam, and tied for first on floor, along with third place finishes on floor and a tie for second place on beam
 - Posted highest scores of the season as a team on vault (49.150) and beam (49.175)
 - They are currently ranked 20th in the nation on vault and 26 th in the nation on floor exercise

- Week Seven: UNH (9-3, 195.650) @ UNC (5-5, 196.050)
UNC (6-5, 196.100) @ UNH (9-4, 195.300)
 - Competing on the road for the second time in three days, UNH registered its best road score (195.650) in Monday night's loss at North Carolina.
 - The Wildcats, who have clinched a share of the inaugural EAGL regular-season championship, sustained their first official league defeat in Sunday's home meet against the Tar Heels at Lundholm Gym. UNH went 4-1 in EAGL meets.
 - Kylie Gorgenyi (Bars, Monday), Alyssa Worthington (Beam, Monday), Emma Winer (Floor, Sunday) and Riley Freehling (AA, Sunday) were New Hampshire's first-place performers for the week.

Towson Current Record: 6-6, 1-3 EAGL

- Week Seven: Towson (6-6, 193.425), Bowling Green (6-8, 194.225), WMU (7-5, 195.075) @ West Virginia (10-6, 196.000)
- Towson had its highest beam and individual event total of the season with a 48.825.
- Ally Wesoly competed all-around for the second time this season, tallying a season-high score of 39.150.
- Camille Vitoff was tied the team's season high and her career-best 9.800 on vault.
- Wesoly led the way on bars and beam with a 9.800 and 9.850, respectively, while Paige Casper led the Tigers with a 9.750 on floor.

GW Current Record: 11-8, 0-3 EAGL

- Week Seven: NC State (10-4, 196.025), NIU (4-4, 195.450) Temple (9-9, 195.075) @ GW (11-8, 195.900)
- In its first podium meet in program history in the Charles E. Smith Center, the George Washington gymnastics team posted a season-high 195.900 to finish second at its Sweet Meet on Sunday afternoon.
- The Colonials earned their season-best score behind a 48.900 on vault, a season-high matching 49.000 on bars, a 48.825 on beam, and season-high 49.175 on floor.
- GW matched its season-high on bars (49.000) and posted a new season-high on floor (49.175).
