

### EAGL 2026 Honors



**Gymnast of the Week** - Senior Isabella Minervini (Fleming Island, Fla.) from Towson was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on Jan 28. Minervini earned a 39.450 in the all around, which is the fourth-highest all-around score in Towson history. The senior has finished first or tied for first in the all around for the third time in as many meets in 2026. She also earned a new career high on beam with a 9.900, tying for 10th in Towson history on that event.

**Specialist of the Week** - Senior Catherine O'Rourke (Arlington, Mass.) from George Washington was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Jan 28. O'Rourke posted a personal best floor score (9.875) and earned a third place overall finish on the event. This score helped guide George Washington to a 49.300 floor rotation, the highest floor team score posted at the meet and a season best for the Revolutionaries.

**Rookie of the Week** - Freshman Brooklyn Thomas (Frederick, Md.) from Temple was voted EAGL Rookie of the Week on Jan 28. Thomas shined on floor for Temple posting a 9.800, finishing tied for 11th place in the event in a very competitive field. This score tied a career-high for the freshman.

**Rookie Specialist of the Week** - Freshman Natalie Lindgren (Fair Haven, N.J.) from Towson was voted EAGL Rookie Specialist of the Week on Jan 28. Lindgren posted a career-high 9.850 on floor, improving in that event for the third straight meet. The freshman finished tied for fifth on floor, tied for second among Towson competitors.

# Weekly Highlights

## **George Washington**

- Current record: 4-5 (0-0 EAGL)
- Week Four outcome: Second place (194.350) at Temple (193.875) with Penn (195.075) and Texas Woman's (193.300)
- George Washington took second at the Temple Quad, ahead of the hosts and Texas Woman's and behind Penn.
- The Revolutionaries had event winners on bars, beam, floor, and in the all-around.
- The team also posted a season-high team score.

## **LIU**

- Current record: 2-5 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Four outcome: Second place (194.000) at Bridgeport (194.050) with Brown (192.375) and Springfield (189.875)
- LIU reached a season-high 194.000 to place second in the quad meet.
- The beam squad reached a season high 48.750 led by Ellorie Cane with a 9.825.
- Raphaelle Perreault led the team on floor with a 9.800 to reach a season high 48.725.

- Week Four outcome: Meet postponed

## **Temple**

- Current record: 4-5 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Four outcome: Third place (193.875) at home against Penn (195.075), George Washington (194.350), and Texas Woman's (193.300)
- Temple shined on floor this week posting its highest score of the season with a 48.900. Three individuals scored a 9.800 or higher and everyone that competed on floor scored above a 9.650.
- Two Owls finished with career-highs on beam. Juniors Hailey Best and Megan White each posted a 9.850 on beam to lead Temple on that apparatus and to mark career-high scores.
- Sophomore Nikki Rengifo posted high scores on vault and floor to help the Owls, especially on floor.

## **Towson**

- Current record: 1-2 (0-0 EAGL)
- Week Four outcome: Loss (195.400) at Arizona (196.800)
- Towson had its top team score of the year against a preseason top-20 opponent.
- The Tigers had two of the top three finishers in the all-around: Isabella Minervini (t-1st) and Polina Belanovski (3rd)
- Isabella Minervini and Celia Trotter each earned career-highs of 9.900 on beam.
