### EAGL 2026 Honors



**Gymnast of the Week** - Sophomore Lola Montevago (Seaford, N.Y.) from George Washington was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on Feb 11. Montevago won the all around for the second week in a row, this time with a personal best score of 39.125. The sophomore had a season high on beam (9.850), matching her career-high and also matched her personal best on vault (9.825), earning second overall and leading the team on both events.

**Specialist of the Week** - Senior Adriana Hoffman (Christiansburg, Va.) from Towson was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Feb 11. Hoffman recorded her first victory on floor this season with a 9.875. This was the highest individual score of the meet and also tied her season high set the previous week.

**Co-Rookies of the Week** - Freshman Aspen Tucker (Suwanee, Ga.) from George Washington and freshman Ella Beck (Westerville, Ohio) from Temple were voted Co-Rookies of the Week on Feb 11. Tucker recorded a personal best score in the all around, finishing second overall. The freshman also recorded her second best bars score of the season (9.700). Beck finished in the top ten in all three events she competed. She posted a new career-high on floor (9.750) that helped Temple achieve a season-high score of 48.975 on the event.

**Co-Rookie Specialists of the Week** - Freshman Jade Harden (Orlando, Fla) from Temple and freshman Eden Stippick (Georgetown, Texas) from LIU were voted EAGL Co-Rookie Specialists of the Week on Feb 11. Harden posted a new personal best 9.825 on vault. This led Temple on the event and tied her for second place. Stippick led the team on vault for the fifth week in a row, placing second overall with a 9.775. The freshman also matched her career high on floor (9.700) for the second week in a row.

## **George Washington**

- Current record: 6-7 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Six outcome: Second place (194.650) at Penn (196.000) with Cornell (192.650) and William & Mary (190.875)
- George Washington recorded a season-high score of 194.650.
- The Revolutionaries posted event scores of 48.475 (vault), 48.425 (bars), 48.875 (beam- season-high) and 48.875 (floor).
- The team also had individual winners in both floor and the all around.

## **LIU**

- Current record: 3-6 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Six outcome: Loss (193.475) at Towson (194.725)
- LIU started the meet with a season high score on bars led by a 9.775 from Brisa Carraro.
- The Sharks reached their second highest score of the season.
- Vault was led by freshman Eden Stippick with a 9.775.

## **New Hampshire**

- Current record: 8-2 (2-0 EAGL)
- Week Six outcome: Win (195.600) at home against Temple (194.500)
- The floor rotation of 49.250 anchored the victory, with four scores of 9.85+ and a winning 9.900.
- Event titles: Vault (Gwen Ockerbloom, 9.850), Beam (T-1st Mady Harvey, 9.850), Bars (Serena Mullin, 9.850), Floor (Serena Mullin, 9.900).

- The Wildcats improved to 2-0 in EAGL, 8-2 on season and 6-0 at home.

## **Temple**

- Current record: 5-8 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Six outcome: Loss (194.500) at New Hampshire (195.600)
- Temple shined on floor this week as the team posted its highest score of the season on the event.
- Temple's 48.975 was highlighted by junior Amelia Budd's career-high 9.850. Junior Mariella Brueck also set a new career-high on floor with her 9.825 on the event, as well as freshman Ella Beck posting her new career-high on floor of a 9.750.
- On the beam, sophomore Nikki Rengifo helped the Owls with her new career-high score of a 9.850. This score is a full .100 higher than her previous career-high.
- Freshman Jade Harden has been a consistent force for Temple on vault. Against New Hampshire, things all came together as she posted a new career-high 9.825.

## **Towson**

- Week Six outcome: Win (194.725) at home against LIU (193.475)
- Towson won all four events as team vs. EAGL opponent LIU.
- The Tigers had individual winners in all events and in the all-around.
