2024 First and Second All-EAGL Teams Announced

TOWSON, Md. (March 18, 2024) – The East Atlantic Gymnastics League announced the first and second all-EAGL teams for the 2024 competitive season on Monday, March 18, as the teams prepare for the EAGL Championship this Saturday, March 23 at Towson.

The first team all-EAGL for each event and in the all around consists of the top eight ranked gymnasts (including ties) from the week 11 regular season.
