

Gymnast of the Week: Senior Kendall Whitman (Pottstown, Pa.) of George Washington was named EAGL Gymnast of the Week for the fourth time this season on March 20. At the Towson tri meet with William & Mary on March 15, Whitman finished first overall on floor with a 9.975. Two days later at GW's quad meet on March 17, the senior recorded a 9.925 on floor for a second place finish against gymnasts from to-30 ranked programs #24 Penn State and #25 Towson. At both meets she led the Revolutionaries on all around, registering a 39.425 on the 15th and a 39.350 on the 17th.

Specialist of the Week: Senior Brooke Donabedian (Maple Valley, Wash.) of Temple picked up her second EAGL Specialist of the Week this season on March 20. At the New Hampshire's quad meet with Bridgeport and Brown on March 17, Donabedian earned her fourth win of the season on beam after logging a career-high 9.925. In six of the 12 meets she has been in the lineup on beam, the senior has scored 9.8 or higher. On floor, she posted a 9.875 which marked her 10th score of 9.8 or better on the event this season.

Rookie of the Week: First-year Maya Peters (Toronto, ON) earned her second EAGL Rookie of the Week award on March 20. At the Towson tri meet on March 15, Peters tied for third overall with a 9.925 on beam. She followed up at GW's quad meet on the 17th with another third place finish on the event after scoring a 9.875. The freshman also competed on bars, placing ninth with a 9.850.

- Logged a season high 49.050 on bars at senior dayquad meet.
- Kendall Whitman received a 10.0 from one judge on floor at Towson tri meet, logging a 9.975 for first place.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 20-12 (2 -2 EAGL)
- Week Ten Outcome: The Wildcats won their final regular season meet against Brown, Temple and Bridgeport with a 195.875.
- Grad student Kylie Gorgenyi collected first place
 finishes on vault (9.875), bars (9.900), floor (9.950)
 and all-around (39.400) to help the 'Cats capture a quad meet victory.
- UNH matched its season high 195.875, finishing ahead of EAGL foe Temple to add another conference win for the 2024 season.
- Sophomore Serena Mullin established a personal best 9.925 on beam, tying for first place.

Temple

- Current record: 14-16 (2-3 EAGL)
- Week Ten Outcome: Finished third at the New Hampshire quad meet with Brown and Bridgeport with a 194.850.
- Logged a season high and fourth best score in program history of 49.175 on bars.
- Senior Brooke Donabedian earned her fourth win of the season on beam with a career-high 9.925.
 - The Cherry and White gymnasts earned eight top-5 marks.

LIU

- Current record: 11-12 (0-3 EAGL)
- Week Ten Outcome: Placed fourth at a quad meet with nationally ranked teams Florida and NC State as well as Iowa State.
- Syd Morris placed fourth overall in all-around with a 39.250.
