

# EAGL 2024 Honors

**Gymnast of the Week:** Graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi (North Reading, Mass.) of New Hampshire was named EAGL Gymnast of the Week on February 7. Gorgenyi posted the Wildcats top vault score, winning the event at the dual meet with Southern Conneticut after logging a 9.850. Gorgenyi won bars as well with a 9.875 and topped the podium in all-around for the third time this season with a 39.125. Currently she ranks first in EAGL on all-around (39.069) and is tied for second in the conference on bars (9.875).

**Specialist of the Week:** Senior Grace Vaillancourt (Hudson, N.H.) of Towson was named EAGL Specialist of the Week on February 7. After competing in a dual meet with Denver on February 4, Vaillancourt surpassed scoring 1000 points throughout her career with Towson. She scored Towson's highest floor score of 9.875, tying for third overall with her second highest score on the event this season. Currently Grace ranks second in EAGL on floor.

**Rookie of the Week:** Freshman Brisa Carraro (Buenes Aires, Argentina) of LIU picked up her second Rookie of the Week this season on February 7. At the dual meet with George Washington on February 4, Carraro earned her second win of the season on bars with a 9.850. She scored a 9.800 for her first time competing on beam, making her mark as the first Shark freshman to score above a 9.8 in their debut on beam.

- Current record: 10-6 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Four Outcome: Back-to-back weekend wins starting with quad meet win (195.175) against Towson (194.225), William & Mary (190.500) and UPenn (194.550) on February 2 followed by dual meet win against LIU, 195.575 - 192.500 on February 4.
- Anneliese Silverman wins all-around with a 39.175 at LIU dual meet.
- Five career highs set at Towson Invite on Feb. 2.
- First Year Sophia Tyeryar set career high of 9.8 on bars at Towson Invite.

### LIU

- Current record: 4-2 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Four Outcome: Fell to George Washington in dual meet, 192.500 195.575 on Feb. 4.
- New competitiors in three events with each athlete scores counting for the team (Bixler - bars, 9.725 / Carraro - beam, 9.8 / Page - floor, 9.725 / Ricketts - floor, 9.825).
- Two event winners on bars (Brisa Carraro) and beam (Syd Morris).

#### New Hampshire

- Current record: 7-2 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Four Outcome: Won dual meet with Southern Connecticut State, 194.550 - 192.350
- Sophomore Serena Mullin became the first UNH gymnast to score a 9.95 on floor in nine years while graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi recorded individual wins on vault, bars and all-around to help lead the team to a Sunday afternoon victory against SCSU, 194.550 192.350.
- Gorgenyi highlighted the vault lineup for UNH with a 9.850, paced bars with a first-place 9.875 and topped the podium in all around (39.125) for the third time this season.
- The Wildcats matched their season high vault score of 49.050, set on Jan. 14.

### Temple

- Current record: 5-7 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Four Outcome: Finished second at Auburn quad meet on Feb. 2 with a score of 193.425. No. 15 Auburn won with 197.425 while Fisk tallied 191.925 and Talladega earned a 188.875.
- The Owls had 14 scores of 9.7 or better during the meet including a pair of 9.8s from senior Renee Schugman and freshman Amelia Budd.
- Schugman scored 9.7 or better in each of her three events (vaut, beam, floor).
