

EAGL 2026 Honors



Gymnast of the Week - Senior Serena Mullin (Hamden, Conn.) from New Hampshire was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on Feb 4. Mullin won three titles at Yale (all around, bars, and floor) to lead the team. All four scores were season highs. The senior was on the podium in five of her eight events across the week. She also had back-to-back 39+ all-around totals (39.225 and 39.050).

Specialist of the Week - Senior Riley Himes (Orlando, Fla.) from New Hampshire was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Feb 4. Himes delivered back-to-back beam career high beam podiums: 2nd at Yale (then PB-9.800) and T-2nd at home with a personal-best 9.850. The senior stabilized New Hampshire's leadoff half of the beam lineup during the season-high 49.050 rotation. All four of her scores from the week counted towards the team's total.

Co-Rookie Specialists of the Week - Freshman Alison Mun (Loudon County, Va.) from George Washington and freshman Eden Stippick (Georgetown, Texas) were voted EAGL Co-Rookie Specialists of the Week on Feb 4. Mun tied for first on vault with a 9.800, leading the Revolutionaries' lineup. Stippick set a new career high of 9.800 on vault leading the team and helping the team to a season high 48.700. She also matched her personal best on floor with a 9.700.

Weekly Highlights

George Washington

- Current record: 4-6 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Loss (191.000) at LIU (192.375)
- George Washington earned 191.000 at LIU, its first EAGL designated meet of the season.
- The Revolutionaries posted event scores of 48.125 (vault), 45.500 (bars), 48.675 (beam) and 48.700 (floor)
- George Washington had the individual winner on each event and in the all around.

LIU

- Current record: 3-5 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Win (192.375) at home against George Washington (191.000)
- LIU started the meet with a season high on vault led by Eden Stippick with a 9.800.
- The Sharks finished first in the EAGL designated meet against George Washington.
- Raphaelle Perreault led the team on floor with a 9.825 to end the meet with the second highest score of the season.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 7-2 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome:
 - Meet 1: Loss (194.150) at Yale (194.200)
 - Meet 2: Win (195.700) at home against Yale (194.975) and Towson (194.925)
- Serena Mullin captured the all-around (39.225) plus bars (9.825) and floor (9.875) at Yale; she later placed 2nd AA (39.050) and T-2nd on floor (9.875) in the home tri-meet.
- New Hampshire posted season highs on beam (49.050) and floor (49.275) in the Feb. 1 win, with multiple podium finishes across both events.

- Sunday's win vs Towson counts in the EAGL regular-season standings to help the Wildcats improve to 7-2 overall, 1-0 in the EAGL.

Temple

- Current record: 5-7 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Third place (192.200) at Georgia (197.675) with Central Michigan (195.900) and Fisk (188.775)
- Temple competed against high-level competition in last Friday's meet in a tough environment, but was able to put up some solid scores through it all.
- Junior Amelia Budd marked the highest score of the night for Temple by scoring a 9.825 on vault. Budd also marked a 9.675 on floor.
- Sophomore Nikki Rengifo competed on three events for Temple in the Georgia Quad Meet and provided stability and consistency in her routines for the Owls. On vault she notched a 9.775, a 9.725 on beam, and a 9.675 on the floor.

Towson

- Current record: 1-4 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Third place (194.925) at New Hampshire (195.700) with Yale (194.975)
- Towson had individual winners in all-around, vault and bars.
- This was the Tigers' third straight meet with a 49+ score on floor.
- It was also the second highest road team score of the season.
