

Co-Gymnasts of the Week - Graduate Student Deja Chambliss (Chesterfield, Va.) from George Washington and Freshman Hallie Copperwheat (Leighton Buzzard, England) from Pittsburgh were voted EAGL Co-Gymnasts of the Week on Feb 9. Chambliss earned a perfect 9.950 on vault on Sunday to take the title and helped George Washington to its highest vault score of the season. In the same meet, she also tied her career-high on bars (9.850) and tied for first overall on floor. The graduate student also earned her third all around title of the season with a career-high 39.425. Copperwheat won four individual titles—vault (9.825), bars (9.875), beam (9.925) and all around (39.500). She also earned or tied career highs on all four events and in the all around. The freshman's all around score of 39.500 is the third highest all around score in Pitt history.

Specialist of the Week - Sophomore Mara Titarsolej (Zutphen, Netherlands) from LIU was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Feb 9. Titarsolej won the bars title at both meets this weekend with scores of 9.950 and 9.925. Her 9.950 set a new LIU program record on the event, which is also the highest score on any event in LIU history.

Rookie of the Week - Freshman Macy Jennings (Apex, N.C.) from NC State was voted EAGL Rookie of the Week on Feb 9. Jennings posted a career-best 9.875 on beam. She tied for third on beam with teammate Nicole Webb, which was her first career podium finish. The freshman also tied for the second-highest beam score on the team.

Weekly Highlights

George Washington

- Current record: 8-6 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome:
- Meet 1: Second place (194.750) at Towson tri meet against Towson (196.225) and William & Mary (189.675)
- Meet 2: First place (196.025) at home quad against Kent State (195.600), Eastern Michigan (195.200) and LIU (193.575)
- George Washington hit a season-high in a first place finish at the Pink Meet on Sunday, the first score above the 196.000 mark this season.
- The Colonials earned season-highs on beam (49.025) and floor (49.125) at Towson and then posted season-highs on vault (49.250) and bars (49.000) in Sunday's home meet.
- The team posted three event scores of 49.000+ in Sunday's season-high finish.

LIU

- Current record: 3-10 (0-4 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome:
- Meet 1: Fourth place (193.350) at Towson quad against Towson (196.700), Temple (194.650) and Eastern Michigan (194.575)
- Meet 2: Fourth place (193.575) at George Washington quad against George Washington (196.025), Kent State (195.600) and Eastern Michigan (195.200)
- LIU recorded the 3rd and 4th highest team scores in the history of the program – 193.575 and 193.350.
- The Sharks set individual school records on bars (9.95 Titarsolej) and tied on vault (9.825 – Bedminster).
- 10 out of 15 competing team members got their personal best scores on one or more of their events competed this weekend.

NC State

- Current record: 7-3 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Third place (194.550) at Pitt quad against WVU (195.925), Pitt (195.800) and Alaska (191.250)
- The Wolfpack was the only team to cross the 49.0 mark on beam at the meet, posting a 49.125.
- NC State collected six podium finishes on the day, including a pair of individual titles.
- The team recorded its second-highest team scores of the season on vault and beam.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 5-5 (2-2 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Loss (193.625) at Denver (196.125)
- Senior Hailey Lui posted UNH's top score of the meet with a 9.825 on floor to finish third.
- Junior Alyssa Worthington placed third on balance beam with a 9.800.
- Freshman Gracy Mowers tied a career high with a 9.800 on vault to pace the Wildcats and earn a share of fourth place.

North Carolina

- Current record: 7-5 (4-0 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Second place (195.325) at Alabama tri meet against Alabama (197.875) and Western Michigan (194.875)

- North Carolina posted the highest team score in Tuscaloosa in program history (five all-time meetings).
- The team earned Carolina's highest road team score of the season.
- The Tar Heels scored their third straight 49.050+ on beam and floor.

Pittsburgh

- Current record: 4-4 (2-1 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Second place (195.800) at home quad against WVU (195.925), NC State (194.550) and Alaska (191.250)
- The Panthers' 195.800 is the team's highest score of the season. The team also earned season-highs on vault (49.025) and bars (48.950), and tied their season-high floor score with a 49.050.
- Hallie Copperwheat secured four individual titles, placing first in everything but floor. Her overall AA score of 39.500 is the third highest all around score in Pitt history.
- Jordyn Ewing tallied a new career high on floor with a 9.875.

Temple

- Current record: 6-3 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome: Second place (194.650) at Towson quad against Towson (196.700), Eastern Michigan (194.575) and LIU (193.350)
- Senior Julianna Roland led the Owls on the night with a pair of 9.9s (vault and floor), including matching her career-high and matching the school record on the vault for the fourth time in her two seasons at Temple.
- The Owls tied two school records on Friday night at the Towson Quad meet, including a score of 49.375 on floor and a 49.150 on yault.
- Freshman Hannah Stallings won her fifth consecutive all-around title with a 38.350.

Towson

- Current record: 10-2 (4-2 EAGL)
- Week Five outcome
- Meet 1: Win (196.225) at home tri meet against George Washington (194.750) and William & Mary (189.675)
- Meet 2: Win at home quad meet against Temple (194.650), Eastern Michigan (194.575) and LIU (193.350)
- It was a huge week for Towson as the Tigers picked up first-place finishes in both a tri- and quad-meet, improving on the season-best each meet.
- Towson scored a 196.700 in a sweep over reigning EAGL champion Temple, Eastern Michigan and LIU, turning in the 19th -highest score in the country this season and the second-highest total outside of the PAC-12, Big 12, SEC and Big 12 (BYU is the lone outlier from the MRGC)
- During the week, Towson scored a program-record 49.400 on beam, tied a program record on vault with a 49.250, scored the second-highest team total in program history (196.700) and hit four 49.000+ rotations in a single meet for the first time in program history.
