GOTW – Senior Michaela Burton (Downers Grove, Ill.) from Pittsburgh was voted EAGL Gymnast of the Week on February 11th after placing first on Bars (9.850). Burton added a third-place finish on Beam (9.875) and a second-place finish on Floor (9.875). This is Pittsburgh's second week in a row with a score of over 195, (195.350), in their close loss against EAGL opponent NC State (196.025).

SOTW – Senior Khazia Hislop (Concord, Mass.) of UNC earned EAGL Specialist of the Week honors on February 11th. Hislop did not score below a 9.800 on any of her three events this weekend, placing first on vault (9.900) and floor (9.825). Khazia also added an excellent finish on beam (9.800) to finish in third-place. The Tar Heels narrowly lost to EAGL opponent Towson this past weekend, 194.325-194.225.

ROTW – Freshman Chloe Negrete (Frisco, Texas) of NC State was named as EAGL Rookie of the Week on February 11th. Negrete achieved her first career score of 9.900 or higher on beam (9.925), placing second in the event. Chloe also tied career-high scores on floor (9.875) and vault (9.800). Negrete helped the Wolfpack defeat EAGL opponent Pittsburgh, 196.025-195.350, enough for the second best score put up by NC State this year.

 The Tigers posted a season-high on vault (led by Freshman Camille Vitoff with a 9.800) and on floor (led by senior Melissa Temkov with a 9.800 and sophomore Emerson Hurst with a 9.800).

•Hurst posted a season-high and the Tigers' highest beam score (9.875), while freshman Amy Stewart (9.875) and junior Tess Zientek (9.850) led the way on bars.
