# EAGL 2024 Honors

**Gymnast of the Week:** Senior Kendall Whitman (Pottstown, Pa.) of George Washington was named EAGL Gymnast of the Week on January 24. Whitman posted a season-high 9.900 on vault at the Next Level Podium Challenge to place first overall. She tied for third on floor, logging a 9.900 which was the highest score for George Washington on the event. The Pennsylvania native has posted the top floor score for the Revolutionaries for all three meets GW has participated in.

**Specialist of the Week:** Senior Brooke Donabedian (Maple Valley, WA) of Temple was named EAGL Specialist of the Week on January 24. Donabedian hit her routine on bars for the second time this season, receiving a 9.700. She anchored the beam and floor lineups for Temple, winning both events with a score of 9.875.

**Rookies of the Week:** Freshmen Brisa Carraro (Buenos Aires, ARG) of LIU and Poulina Minaev (Smithtown, N.Y.) of New Hampshire were voted EAGL Co-Rookies of the Week on January 24. Carraro had her collegiate debut this past weekend, placing first overall on bars with a 9.875. Minaev led the floor lineup, earning a career-high 9.875 to tie for second overall. She improved her floor score by .025 between week one and two. Minaev helped UNH achieve a quad meet victory, posting the team's highest score on floor.

## Weekly Highlights

### **George Washington**

- Current record: 5-4 (1-0 EAGL)
- Week Two Outcome: Third place finish at the Next Level Podium Challenge with a 193.475 against Illinois State (195.900) and Western Michigan (196.125).
- Posted a season-high team score of 49.025 on vault.
- First-place finish overall on vault (9.9) from Kendall Whitman.
- Brooke Izzo posted team's highest score on beam (9.750) for her collegiate debut.

### **LIU**

- Current record: 4-1 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Two Outcome: Placed second at a quad meet with a score of 192.825 against New Hampshire (195.400), Yale (192.350) and SCSU (191.925).
- Had two event winners on bars (Brisa Carraro) and beam (Alana Ricketts).
- Tied for highest team bars score of the meet (48.800).

### **New Hampshire**

- Current record: 4-1 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Two Outcome: quad meet victory with a season high score of 195.400, defeating LIU (192.825), Yale (192.350) and SCSU (191.925)
- Graduate student Kylie Gorgenyi finished first on vault, tied for first on bars, placed second on floor and won the AA competition.
- The Wildcats posted the highest team score on vault (48.975), tied LIU for the top mark on bars (48.000) and registered the highest score on beam (48.550). UNH's highest score was on floor (49.075).

### **Temple**

- Current record: 3-6 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Two Outcome: scored a season high 195.900 at a dual meet to defeat Towson (195.325), picking up their third win of the season.
- Highest home opener score in program history, highest January score and third highest score in program history (195.900).
- Recorded their first vault score over 49 this season.
- Recorded a 49.175 on their final event of floor, not counting any score lower than 9.8.

# Weekly Highlights

## Towson

- Current record: 0-4 (0-1 EAGL)
- Week Two Outcome: Placed second in a dual meet with Temple (195.900) after posting a (195.325).
- Improved beam score by 1.05 from score at season opener - posting 48.800, and team score by .100.
- Four Tigers finished in the top-3 individually including a first-place finish from Isabella Minervini on bars.
- Several gymnasts posted season highs.
