EAGL 2026 Honors



Co-Gymnasts of the Week - Sophomore Raphaëlle Perreault (Sherbrooke, Quebec, Canada) from LIU and Senior Isabella Minervini (Fleming Island, Fla.) from Towson were voted EAGL Co-Gymnasts of the Week on Feb 18. Perreault won her first all around title with a career best 39.025. The sophomore also recorded a career high 9.850 on floor to help the Sharks earn a season high 49.250 to start the meet. She also placed second on vault with a career high 9.800 and third on beam with a season high 9.800. Minervini recorded a 9.950 bars score on Sunday, which ties for third-highest bars score in Towson history. The senior also earned her sixth and seventh all-around victories in seven Towson meets this season.

Specialist of the Week - Senior Adriana Hoffman (Christiansburg, Va.) from Towson was voted EAGL Specialist of the Week on Feb 18. Hoffman recorded her second victory on vault this season on Sunday with a 9.875, which was a new career high. The senior recorded a 9.800 and 9.850 on floor on Friday and Sunday respectively and has earned at least a 9.800 on floor in each of her last four meets.

Co-Rookies of the Week - Sophomore Camille Lund Rasmussen (Copenhagen, Denmark) from LIU and freshman Natalie Lindgren (Fair Haven, N.J.) from Towson were voted Co-Rookies of the Week on Feb 18. Rasmussen set a new career high 9.875 on floor to lead the Sharks with the highest score of the season on any event. The sophomore won her first career event title on floor, competing in just her second career routine. Lindgren tied a career-high 9.800 on beam on Sunday and set new career-highs on bars on both Friday and Sunday, having competed in the rotation on bars for just second and third time.

Rookie Specialist of the Week - Freshman Jocelyn Lannon (Sutton, Mass.) from Towson was voted EAGL Rookie Specialist of the Week on Feb 18. Lannon earned first-ever victory on Friday and podium finishes on vault for Towson on both Friday and Sunday. Her 9.850 ties the highest score for a Towson athlete on vault this year.

Weekly Highlights

George Washington

- Current record: 7-8 (0-2 EAGL)
- Week Seven outcome: Second place (193.400) at home against New Hampshire (194.650) and William & Mary (192.000)
- George Washington finished second at home with a 193.400, behind New Hampshire and ahead of William & Mary
- The Revolutionaries posted event scores of 48.775 (vault), 48.575 (bars- season-high), 47.200 (beam) and 48.850 (floor)
- The team had individual winners in each of the four events, including the all around

LIU

- Current record: 8-6 (1-2 EAGL)
- Week Seven outcome: First place (194.750) at Cortland (191.950) with Cornell (192.850), Brockport (192.000), Ithaca (189.500), and Utica (188.500)
- LIU started the meet with a season high and second highest in program history on floor, a 49.250.
- The Sharks reached a season-high 194.750 — the program's highest score since Taylor Colwell took the helm.
- The team ended with a season high on beam with a 48.800 to win the Empire State Collegiate Championship for the first time in program history.

New Hampshire

- Current record: 10-2 (3-0 EAGL)
- Week Seven outcome: First place (194.650) at George Washington (193.400) with William & Mary (192.000)
- New Hampshire clinched at least a share of the EAGL regular season championship by improving to 3-0 in league competition. The Wildcats are 5-0 in all competitions vs EAGL opponents.
- The Wildcats won bars with a 48.825, led by sophomore Peyton Novinger's career-high-tying 9.825 for second place. New Hampshire owns the EAGL's top bars NQS (48.755).

- Sophomore Mady Harvey scored a 9.850 to share first place on beam. Harvey is the EAGL's No. 1 ranked beam competitor with a 9.845 NQS. The Wildcats' 48.694 beam NQS also leads the league.

Temple

- Current record: 6-10 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Seven outcome: Third place (193.375) at home against Brown (194.025), Yale (194.025), and William & Mary (191.775)
- Temple junior Amelia Budd shined for the home squad in the meet on Friday. She competed on vault and floor and posted a 9.825 on both events, which were some of the highest scores of the night overall for an individual.
- Nikki Rengifo performed strong for the Owls overall, posting three scores above a 9.625 on the night. Her high came on vault with a season high score for the team (9.800).
- Juniors Hailey Best, Megan White, and Mariella Brueck also helped the Owls throughout the meet Friday. Best's 9.825 on beam was the second-highest score of the season for her, and the highest one of the night on the event for Temple. White finished with a team-high 9.725 on bars and a 9.800 on the beam. Brueck notched her third 9.800 on the floor of the season in Friday's meet.

Towson

- Current record: 5-5 (1-1 EAGL)
- Week Seven outcome:
 - Meet 1: First place (195.325) at West Chester (191.575) with Ursinus (191.950)
 - Meet 2: Second place (194.825) at Penn (195.550) with West Chester (192.450)
- Towson combined for three 49+ rotation team scores and two 48.950s.
- In individual events, the Tigers won both all-around, bars, vaults and floor exercises.
- The team earned three victories in two meets in Philadelphia for 3-1 record.
